

**Guidelines for submitting the final version** of your paper for publication in  
15th DSS 2010 IFIP WG 8.3 International Conference on Decision Support Systems Supplemental  
Proceedings, University of Lisbon, Lisbon, Portugal

Please

Format your manuscript according to the IOS Press template for papers, available through the conference website <http://dss2010.di.fc.ul.pt/index.php?title=Submission> and in [http://www.iospress.com/authco/instruction\\_crc.html](http://www.iospress.com/authco/instruction_crc.html). This involves including an abstract and set of keywords, following the layout (page size, maximum number of pages, fonts and font sizes, formatting of headers, etc.) and a clear legibility of figures and graphs when reproduced in black and white. References should be carefully verified for correctness (in particular, look out for mistakes in names of authors and editors, but verify also e.g. correct upper-/lower casing of acronyms) and completeness of the information provided (specification of editors, publisher and location, full conference titles when citing from proceedings, names of series, volume and issue numbers, page numbers, etc.). Do not insert page numbers or running headlines.

Respect the maximum length limitation on the number of pages.

Generate a pdf version.

Write a response to the reviewers' comments specifying how you took them into account.



Download and print the "License to publish" agreement. Sign it and produce a digital version of the signed document.

Make a zip file including:

- the source file of the manuscript (MS Word or Latex files)
- the pdf version of the manuscript
- the response to the reviewers' comments
- the signed "License to publish" agreement

Enter your Easychair account and select the DSS 2010 space.

Select the paper to upload. If you have multiple submissions this option is under "My submissions".
